## Description

The Jug stands on a spreading foot and is decorated with an applied reeded band at the rim. This piece, unusually, has a faceted sparrow beak pouring spout and plain loop handle. As you will appreciate, the design of this piece has a contemporary feel to it, although it was made in 1793.
