

A very rare Heraldic Wine Label unmarked, but made almost certainly in London circa 1775, possibly by Samuel Meriton.

Description

This very rare label is modelled in the rare heraldic style, with a narrow rectangular banner, with oval cartouche above, flanked by supporters. The borders are decorated with beading and this example is pierced for WHITE WINE.. The cartouche is engraved with a contemporary Crest and most unusually, this piece has been pierced upside down. A mistake which wine label collectors often find desirable. The label is in excellent condition. Although unmarked, this was a design which was made by Samuel Meriton.
