

A very rare William IV Chinoiserie Miniature Teapot made in Birmingham in 1837 by Joseph Willmore.

Description

This extremely rare piece is modelled in an unusual square form and each side is decorated with exotic trees and flowerheads, in relief, on a matted ground. This is a rare Chinoiserie design. The hinged cover is decorated in the same manner as the sides and terminates in a raying flower head. The scroll handle is decorated with single flower heads, as is the fluted scroll handle, which unusually has a spout pin, also with a flower head on the end. This beautiful piece is in excellent condition and is very well marked on the base. Length, handle to spout: 2.25 inches, 5.63 cm. Height: 1.5 inches, 3.75 cm.
