Description

This unusual basket stands on an oval pedestal foot decorated with reeding. The deep oval body rises to a reeded rim with cast "Onslow" ends for carrying attached to the main body with acanthus leaf mouldings.

This piece lends itself to a variety of uses and is in excellent condition, displaying a crisp set of marks in the foot. Length: 7.25 inches. Width: 3.9 inches. Height, to the top of the handle: 4.5 inches. Weight: 10oz
