Description

The Dessert Service comprises of fourteen pairs of Dessert Knives and Forks (28 pieces in total). Each piece has a beautiful chamfered shaded Scottish agate handle, the forks with silver tines and the knives with silver blades. The handles are attached to the silver with a ribbed moulding. The Service is in excellent condition and each piece is very well marked. All pieces are contained within a velvet lined, fitted, brass bound case, with removable tray.
