Description

The Chamberstick has a circular base, with a raised border decorated with gadrooning. The central baluster shaped shaft has a tulip shaped socket and this section is unusually cast. This piece has a reeded nozzle and conical shaped extinguisher. The circular finger ring is also decorated with unusual linear designs. Most unusually, this piece all comes apart so that it could be easily transported during a military campaign. Each piece is very well marked and engraved with the number "2". It is most unusual to see campaign chambersticks, especially of this size. This is certainly the first we have offered over all of the years.
