

Nathaniel Mills. A rare Windmill Vinaigrette made in Birmingham in 1846 by Nathaniel Mills

Description

The Vinaigrette is broad rectangular in form with shaped sides. The incuse sides are decorated with engine turning and the base with different bands of engine turning around a scroll cartouche containing a contemporary Crest. The cover is engraved with a very unusual scene featuring a detailed Windmill with a lake, and promontories with buildings and hills against a rayed sky. The engraving has been executed to a very high standard. The interior displays exceptional gilding and a grille pierced and engraved with pluming scrolls within a bright cut frame. The interior is very well marked, including a maker's mark on the underside of the grille. The Windmill scene is a very rare subject to find on a Vinaigrette, especially by Nathaniel Mills.
