## Description

The Case has a pull off cover and narrow rectangular form, with cut corners and slightly tapering sides. The case is engraved with foliate sprays on a scratch engraved ground surrounded by prick dot frames. Each side also displays a vacant diamond shaped cartouche. This piece is fully marked on the cover and with the maker's mark on the base.
