Description

The Vinaigrette is broad rectangular in form with cut corners. The sides and base are engraved with prick dot borders and the cover with chequered designs around a central oval cartouche containing contemporary script initials. The interior displays fine gilding and a grille decorated with an oval filigree panel.
